LTI Reaches Major Milestone

In November KCGM reached a major milestone, with the Loss Time Injury (LTI) Bonus reaching an impressive 2 million hours without a Lost Time Injury (LTI). Thanks to the votes of our KCGM employees and contractors, donations of \$12,000 each, has been made to joint winners, Police and Community Youth Centre (PCYC) and Foodbank.

PCYC Kalgoorlie is a community youth centre that works in partnership with other community agencies to engage young people and implement programs to reduce offending behaviour and crime within the Goldfields District. PCYC has recently had a one million dollar up-grade, with its grand re-opening to the public, scheduled for Saturday February 18, 2017. KCGM's bonus will go towards ensuring PCYC can continue to provide great facilities and engaging activities/recreation to the local youth.

Foodbank is a non-denominational, non-profit organisation which acts as a pantry to the charities and community groups who feed the hungry. Foodbank has been in Kalgoorlie since July, 2011 and has fed hundreds of local families. Foodbank Kalgoorlie WA Branch Manager Sandy King said that their biggest challenge is finding good quality vegetables and fruit locally, "I would like to see Foodbank Kalgoorlie-Boulder have a garden retic system put in. We also want to put in a Fruit and Veg Community Garden so we can grow our own foods to provide to the local Goldfields people. Thanks to the generosity of KCGM employees, this is looking like it will become a reality for us. I get goose bumps just thinking about the changes we can now make."
