KCGM Underground Offices Moving to Cassidy Centre

As of the 27 March, the Mt Charlotte offices, currently located at the Sam Pearce Decline will be moving to refurbished offices at the Cassidy Centre in Williamstown. The Mt Charlotte crew will be relocating on the 3 April.

This move has been undertaken as part of the KCGM Full Potential program which identifies business improvement opportunities across both operational and support areas in order to become more efficient and productive whilst ensuring our goal of safe production.

This project identified a reduction in costs and time by facilitating the move to Cassidy as it will provide modern facilities as well as easier access to and from work each shift. The Cassidy Shaft will become the new access point for staff to go underground each day.

General Manager Ian Butler states “Like all good businesses, it is important to review our operations to ensure we find opportunities to extend mine life and stay focused on a combination of long term sustainable projects and cost reduction. Moving our underground staff to the Cassidy Offices shows our long term commitment to our employees and the Kalgoorlie-Boulder community. An official opening of the Cassidy Offices will be taking place in early May to mark this special transition from Fimiston Operations to the Cassidy Centre.
