KCGM Finalist for Community Partnership Award

KCGM's long-standing community partnership with Kalgoorlie-Boulder Urban Landcare Group (KBULG) has been announced as a finalist for the Department of Mines, Industry Regulation and Safety (DMIRS) Community Partnership Resources Sector Awards.

One of nine finalists, it has been recognised as a meaningful partnership within the resources sector that extends beyond the lifetime of the mine.

Kim Eckert, KBULG CEO, said the long-standing successful partnership with KCGM played a big part in the environmental sustainability of Kalgoorlie-Boulder and that she was proud that it had been announced as a finalist.

KCGM has been supporting KBULG for over 12 years, most recently with their 3-year \$60,000 partnership. KCGM and KBULG have worked in unison in a number of key cultural and environmental awareness events in Kalgoorlie-Boulder.

The Community Partnership Resources Sector Award is a state-wide award, which recognises partnerships between communities, and/or community groups, and WA resources and extractive industry organisations. Winners will be announced at the Department's Awards for Excellence Night on Thursday October 26, along with the prestigious Golden Gecko Environmental Excellence Award and the inaugural Safety and Health Resources Sector Awards.
